Book of the month.

West Wickham Past into Present

This book comprises two halves. Hamlet into Village by Patricia KNOWLDEN and Village into Suburb by Joyce WALKER. This book has been thoroughly researched and exceptionally well-illustrated. It includes planning permission for a weekly market and yearly fair dated May 16th 1318 and street plans for 1484 and a map showing tenements in 1310. It shows that the estimated number of people living in West Wickham in 1086 was 110 and the counted number in 1981 was 19,344. Many families are featured and the history of some of the farms starts as early as the 14th century. Points of interest and a suggested route are given for anyone wanting to walk around the area. This is a must read for anyone with ancestors from the area and the book is very **reasonably priced at £6** from the bookstall.
